

a) The Project Work

The project work is a 1000 words essay on the following areas of investigation. It is important to write on your paper the title, your name(s), registration number(s), date and the words number of your essay. Do not forget to refer to your sources, other wise you will be considered as having plagiarized other people's ideas. Finally, you can work either on your own or in pairs. Bear in mind that the areas of investigation are too broad, so you better narrow down the topic of your choice. In case that you want to write about something not included in the following topics list, make sure it is relevant to "materials science and technology", or e-mail me your topic title.

- 1) Application of ceramics in industry.
- 2) Application of biomaterials in industry.
- 3) Polymers and recycling/ or / Recycling of materials.
- 4) Environment friendly means of transportation.
- 5) Food industry: how safe are organic products?
- 6) Types of nanomaterials – smart materials.

Note: You are expected to hand in your papers on the date of the final exam (24th January). You may also send your work through e-mail.
